BACKGROUND

The 2022 Guernsey Design Awards will honour distinctive, original, inspirational and sustainable design of the built environment in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

There will also be a 'People's Choice' award with a winner to be chosen by the public from a shortlist of entrants and a 'Professionals' Choice' to be voted for by attendees at the presentation evening.

PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY

Submissions are invited from entrants whose works fall within, but are not limited to, the following categories:

- New buildings
- Extensions and alterations
- Public realm projects
- Designed landscapes
- Works to protected buildings and monuments
- Infrastructure works
- Restoration projects
- Lighting schemes
- Public art projects
- Conversion and refurbishment

Conceptual projects such as masterplans or projects that are not yet complete cannot be accepted. Separate elements of a phased development will be considered. Entries will be limited to the built environment in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

TIMESCALES AND LIMITATIONS

Entries are limited to projects in the Bailiwick of Guernsey. Projects must have been completed between the 22nd November 2019 (the day after qualification date for 2020 awards entries) and 26th November 2021. Entries submitted to the 2022 Guernsey Design Awards will not be eligible for entry in subsequent Guernsey Design Awards.

ENTRY FEE

There is no entry fee for the Guernsey Design Awards 2022.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS

Entries may be submitted until 5pm on Friday 26th November 2021.

CATEGORIES AND JUDGING

Projects will be judged on the overall quality of design, use of materials, the relationship to setting, sustainability and adherence to the client brief. Consideration will also be given to client/end user satisfaction.

Provisional categories for the 2022 Awards are:

- Small Projects (up to 250k)
- Single Residential New Build
- Single Residential Renovation/Extension
- Commercial
- Heritage
- Multiple Residential Development

Entrants should assign their nominated projects to the one category they think it is best suited to. However, categories will be flexible and the judging committee may reorganise, merge or remove categories in which case they will re-assign projects accordingly.

JUDGING CRITERIA (WHERE APPLICABLE)

DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

- How the project demonstrates design excellence
- How it is an exemplar of its type, demonstrates innovation and is likely to remain a fine work of architecture throughout its life
- Response to site constraints and opportunities
- Quality of finishes, detail & workmanship
- Outperforms statutory minimum standards, where possible

HEALTH AND WELL BEING

- Internal space standards and layout
- Flexibility of internal layout to adapt to the changing needs of the occupier
- Safety and security
- Accessibility for people of all ages and abilities
- Internal daylight standards and potential to receive direct sunlight
- Private or communal gardens, terraces or balconies
- Satisfaction of end users

HOW TO ENTER

You can enter as many projects as you like.

Entries are required in electronic format. Entrants should submit the following:

1. Electronic copies of the completed entry form
2. Up to 10 photographs and 5 plans
Photographs and plans should clearly show the scope of the work undertaken. Where appropriate you should include one 'before' image; one interior and one exterior image of the completed scheme. **Please ensure that electronic copies of photographs and plans are in jpeg format, and should be of minimum 300dpi resolution.**
3. A copy (can be an email) of written permission of the building owner for entry and for subsequent publicity, where applicable

Method of entry is via a file transfer service such as **wetransfer.com** or **hightail.com** to: contact@guernseydesignawards.com (Please contact us if you cannot use these).

Entries accepted until 5pm on **Friday 26th November 2021**

Please note:

- If the submission is not from the building owner, the written permission of the building owner will be required for entry to the Awards.
- For photographs you must obtain permission from the photographer and anyone who is recognisable in the photograph.
- Drone footage / video can be submitted but in the interest of fairness it will not be seen by the judges. However, it may be used in the awards presentation if the entry is shortlisted.
- The organisers of the Awards reserve the right to exhibit part of the whole of each entry, including on its website and in the media.
- All entries to the Design Awards are non-returnable.

CHARACTER

- Retention and integration of existing of site features such as trees, landscape, topography, archaeology into the scheme
- Relationship to the surroundings, such as movement and landscape as well as existing buildings and structures

ENVIRONMENT

- Minimising energy and water consumption, surface water run-off, waste pollution, and select materials with a low environmental impact
- Recycling and waste management
- Protecting or enhancing the ecological value of the site
- How it has responded to a site of historic significance (if applicable)

ASSESSMENT AND PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

First stage: Initial Assessment

Initial assessment is on the basis of the completed entry form and accompanying photographs/plans.

Shortlisted entrants will be notified of their place on the shortlist in January 2022 and may be asked to submit additional information and images. The information and images may be used for inclusion in the project's display panel at the exhibition stage.

The judges' shortlist decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Final stage: Judging panel site visits and 'People's Choice'

During January 2022 final site visits are made by the judging panel and decisions made on overall winner and commendations.

The 'People's Choice' voting period will run between 9th February to 1st March 2022

Winners and commendations, as determined by the Design Awards judging panel and People's Choice award, as determined by the residents of Guernsey, will be presented at an awards ceremony on Friday 25th March 2022 at Princess Royal Centre for Performing Arts. More than one award/commendation may be presented to the same entrant.
